

You can set the course of your life by the vision of your heart.

As we continue our study of faith and grace I feel impressed by the Spirit of God to say a few words about visions or visualization.

The Word of God says that **where there is no vision, the people perish** (Prov.29:18). God has made us in His image and whatever we can imagine or see in our hearts and spirits based on the Word of God, that is our faith and future. However, faith is not hoping that we will see the answer in the future, faith is believing that we have the answer now. The eyes of faith see the answer as having already happened based on our faith in God's Word. (Heb. 11:1)

My son pay attention to my words, listen to what I have to say. <u>Let them not get out of your sight, keep them in the center of your heart.</u> For they will bring life to those to whom they are revealed and healing energy to every cell of their body. (Prov.4:20-22, paraphrased version)

<u>Meditate</u> on the Word of healing (by His stripes you were healed, 1 Peter 2:24) and it will give you a <u>revelation</u> of that Word and that in turn will lead to a <u>manifestation</u> of divine health and healing in your life.

The bible tells us in Genesis 11 about how the people in those days were one, had one language, and God said that because of this, *nothing would restrain them* from doing whatever they could *imagine to do*. I heard a few years ago about how the New Age movement taught their people how to visualize. Some Christian leaders got upset, thinking that this was very dangerous, and that it would open people up to demon possession. What they overlooked is that *God is the original teacher of visualization*.

As we read the Word of God we can see that this is the way that God tells us to operate in *His Kingdom* or in *His system* of doing things. It is the way that Jesus operated. Jesus said unto them, "Verily, verily I say unto you, *The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth* the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise." (John 5:19) And then we see in John 14:12 that *the works that Jesus did we shall do also*.

Remember, what we see in our hearts today will come to pass tomorrow. So let us fill our eyes and hearts with God's lifegiving, positive Word and that way abort the negative visions of the enemy.
