

How To Hear The Voice Of God.

(December 7, 2004)

<u>The sheep follow the shepherd for they know His voice.</u> (John 10:4) To hear His voice is one of the most wonderful things that we as humans can experience here on earth. In John 10 we are likened unto sheep following the shepherd and hearing His voice. That tells us that every Christian can hear and know the voice of the Father.

I am frequently asked: "How can we discern between His voice and other voices?"

The Word of God is quick (alive), powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner (judge) of the thoughts and intents of the heart. (Hebrews 4:12)

The Word is the Father speaking to us and that Word will change us as we spend time with it. Then and only then can we learn to discern between the Father's voice and other voices. This is the main reason for "Föda för ditt Hjärta" (Food for the Heart). To help and encourage artists to hear and know God's voice on their own, and thereby know His will in their, sometimes, difficult situations. I will even take it a step further, He is calling us to be His voice, prophetic artists.

We are not claiming to know it all or to be perfect in our doctrine, for the Word says that we go from glory to glory, but we are simply and honestly sharing our hearts and thoughts in trying to bless those that hunger and thirst for a closer walk with the Father.

As a child I hungered for that intimate walk as I could see it in the life of my own father. For him it was more than going to church or a religious doctrine, it was a **personal**, **daily relationship with his heavenly Father**.

The children of *Israel heard the voice of God* and were terrified. *Samuel heard the voice of God* and did, in the beginning, not know what it was. *Paul heard the voice of God* and obeyed it which, in turn, **changed his life and countless numbers of other lives through him because he walked and talked with God.**

Sometimes that voice is *still and small*. Sometimes it's *like thunder*. Sometimes it's just *a peace or a knowing in the heart*. But it is *always to the heart* that God speaks. *The spirit of man is the candle of the Lord* (Proverbs 20:27). *There is where we find the light and revelation from the Father. There is where we find the voice of God. It is in our born-again and spirit-filled hearts.*

Here are **a few** of the things that the Father has showed me **that can help us as prophetic artists to become <u>more</u> <u>sensitive to His voice</u> in our daily walk with Him:**

- 1. **Spending time in the Word** and meditating on it. Psalms 1:2
- 2. Renewing our mind by thinking and speaking God's Word, not thoughts and words that are against His Word. Romans 12:2
- 3. Being open to change. Isaiah 43:18-19
- 4. **Praying in the Spirit** and speaking in tongues. Romans 8:26-27
- 5. Practicing being sensitive to small impressions and obeying them. Romans 8:14
- 6. Presenting our bodies a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God through fasting. Romans 12:1
- 7. Denying selfish tendencies the right to rule our lives. Matthew 10:38
- 8. Walking in Light and forgiveness. 1 John 1:7 and Matthew 6:14-15
