



Led By The Spirit Of God In 2005.

(February 13, 2005)

Both shocking and wonderful things happened in 2004 **and even more so will take place in 2005**. In order to be protected and safe, we need to get into the arc of safety by being led by the Spirit of God in our daily lives and artistic careers. As we walk with the **Angel of His presence**, we will be safe and productive for the Kingdom of God. Here is a short study to help you do just that.

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. For we have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear, but we have received the Spirit of adoption whereby we cry, Abba, Father. The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit, that **we are the sons of God**. Romans 8:14-16

When we study the life of Jesus our elder brother (Rom. 8:29), we find that He was always led by the Spirit of God. **This is and was the key to the supernatural and prophetic ministry of Jesus** (Hebrews 10:38). And as He is, so are we in this world. (1 John 4:17)

John 5:19 says that the Son can do nothing of himself, but what He sees the Father do. For whatsoever the Father does, these things does the Son also. In other words, **Jesus walked and WORKED being led by the Spirit of God.**

In John chapter 3 verse 8, the Spirit is likened to a wind that blows that when is heard, one is not sure of it's direction. That is how it is with the born-again and Spirit-led believer. The Lord showed me a vision of a sail boat with the wind blowing in it's sail, moving it with speed across the waters. Then **He told me that the greatest thing that I could do with my life was to find the wind of God, and then just allow Him to move me in the direction He desires.**

Peter was led by the Spirit when he, on Jesus' invitation, stepped out of the boat and started to walk on the water. **He heard from God and acted on the word that he heard.** As he heard, faith was conceived in his heart because **faith comes by hearing from God**, Romans 10:17. **As he acted on that Word from God (but be you doers of the word, not only hearers, James 1:22), his faith was released and the miracle happened.**

Paul the apostle was led by the Spirit when he, after many days, had been **flattered by an evil spirit that seemingly was telling the truth, Acts 16:17-18**. The Word says that Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit: **"I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her."**

Because Paul was anointed and led by the spirit to speak those words, the evil spirit came out the same moment. This is the gift of faith and the gift of miracles in operation.

Being led by the Spirit of God is **not in the realm of reasoning**, but in the realm of faith and in the realm of the spirit. Therefore, it requires knowledge and study of the Word of God, much prayer (talking with God), and daily practice in order to develop. **So that we can be led by the Spirit of God, our Father, as sons and daughters protected by His mercy and His grace.**

Words to study: Romans 8:14-16, 8:29, 10:17; 1 John 4:17; Hebrews 10:38; John 3:8, 5:19; James 1:22, Acts 16:17-18.
