

What To Do With A Prophetic Word From God.

It is in light of what just happened at the Gulf cost region of the United States that I am endeavoring to write this short teaching and admonition of **listening to God's prophetic voice in the earth.**

Jesus said that His return would be in a moment "when ye think not" (Matthew 24:44). This is a prophetic Word about His return that will be fulfilled in a moment when most people think not. What is the remedy?

Jesus said: "watch and pray." (Matthew 24:42, 25:41)

The truth is that this is the way it is with many prophetic words. They come to pass when we think not.

Earlier this year my wife, Consuelo, received a warning for Sweden and shortly after that the Lord told me that without repentance, this word will come to pass when the people think not.

I have heard and read that prophets in Sweden, in other European countries, in Latin America, and in the United States, have had other prophetic words from God that will come to pass in a *"moment that ye think not"*.

Few people thought the tragedy we now see unfolding in the U.S. would come to pass, although *it had been prophesied* earlier this year by prophets in the U.S. and other nations.

When we first came to the U.S., the Lord instructed me to go on TV to preach *a word of repentance to the church in order to avoid judgement*. He gave me dreams about great destruction, such as we see now, and even worse, that would come to pass in the U.S. if there was no profound repentance in the church.

But He also said that there would be a great move of His Spirit in the U.S.-- greater than this nation has ever seen. And I believe that we are now seeing the beginnings of that prophetic word.

God is a God of mercy, but He is also a Holy God and His Word is a Holy Word. He will always speak through His prophetic voice in the earth to save and to heal and to deliver all that will turn to Him with all their hearts and all their minds.

The Bible says that what a man sows, that also shall he reap (Galatians 6:7). Romans 6:23 notes that "the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ." God showed Kenneth Hagin, before he went to be with the Lord, that 2005 would be a year of judgement, overflow, and harvest. There will be good harvest for those who have sown good seed and bad harvest for those who have sown bad seed. Let's all repent if there is anything in our lives that is not pleasing to the Lord.

Mark 1:15 (Amplified Version) reads, "The [appointed period of] time is fulfilled (completed), and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent (have a change of mind which issues in regret for past sins and in change of conduct for the better) and believe (trust in, rely on, and adhere to) the good news (the Gospel)."

Many of these disasters will be blamed on "global warming" and maybe that is part of the reason, but it does not solely cause these natural disaster that will befall the world.

Yet, simultaneously the greatest moves of God will and are taking place in nations all over the world.

The Spirit of God says in Isaiah 26:9, "for only when Your judgments are in the earth will the inhabitants of the world learn righteousness (uprightness and right standing with God)." Verse 16 states, "Lord, when they were in trouble and distress, they sought and visited you, they poured out a prayerful whisper when Your chastening was upon them."

The Word of God also teaches us, "do not spurn the gifts and utterances of the prophets [do not depreciate prophetic revelations nor despise inspired instruction or exhortation or warning]." (1 Thessalonians. 5:20)

So let us all "watch and pray" with proper respect for the prophetic voice of God, for in a moment when we think not, **the prophetic word of the Lord will surely come to pass.**
