

God Wants You To Live Your Dream.

(December 3, 2008)

Let your God-given dreams come true. Don't let the devil steal them. They are God's gift to you.

The Word says: "The thief comes only to steal, kill, and destroy. I am come that you may have life, and have it in abundance." (John 10:10)

The Word of God also says that the Lord will give us the desires of our hearts if we delight in Him and in His Word.

The way God works is that He will put His desires in our hearts so we can seek them.

"Delight thyself in the Lord and He will give thee the desires of thine heart, commit thy way unto the Lord, trust also in Him and He shall bring it to pass." (Psalms 37:4-5)

These two scriptures are keys to the unlocking of the dreams, and to giving birth to God's plans for our lives.

After you have received the dream, you must protect and cultivate the God-given vision, and rejoice in the purpose of our Creator for your life.

The Lord has created each of us for a specific purpose, and that purpose is communicated to us through dreams, visions, and intuitions; and all these are received in our spirits.

Therefore, it is sometimes easier for nations and cultures which are closer to nature and simplicity, to receive, with childlike faith, what God has promised.

However, God gives us all dreams when we delight in Him and seek His ways with commitment and faith. Proverbs 20:27 says: "The spirit of man is the candle of the Lord (the light of God is in our spirits)."

The purpose of the prophetic <u>artist</u> (a word which is related to the Hebrew word, *Amen*) is all about tapping into the atmosphere of heaven and bringing it into the earth realm.

One example of a prophetic dreamer, in the Bible, is Joseph. He had to find out about his life and destiny through dreams. The devil tried to stop him and to kill the dreams, **but Joseph held onto the dreams by serving God inspite of persecutions.**

Eventually, God promoted him because Joseph was faithful in pursuing that prophetic dream which brought life and salvation to the nations.

We will hear from God regarding our lives if we ask Him to speak to us!

I myself knew very little about who I was and what my gift and calling were before I started seeking God through prayer, fasting, and a profound study of the Word. I had to learn to listen to my spirit regarding my life and take steps of faith, knowing I was called to serve others with my gift.

After we have heard from God in our spirits, we will have faith, because faith comes by hearing from God. (Romans 10:17) We will have faith to pursue our dream, although the enemy will try to discourage us and steal that Word that the Lord has given to us to act upon. (James 1:22)

Don't give up, but keep believing like Abraham that what God has promised, He is able also to perform. (Romans 4:21) Hallelujah!
