The Wonderful Voice of God

(November 19, 2012)

The other morning I woke up by hearing the sweet voice of the Holy Spirit. As I got up to pray about what He had just told me, I started to contemplate the sweetness and the power of His voice.

Jesus said that the sheep hear the shepherd's (Jesus') voice. (John 10:4)

God's voice is speaking today to every believer in the earth, and even to the unbelievers. The question is not if He is speaking, but rather if are we listening.

People often come to me and ask if I have a word from the Lord for them. Sometimes the Lord will give me a word for them, and sometimes He will not. Paul said, by the Spirit of God: "So then faith comes by hearing an anointed word from the Lord." It reads from the Greek that faith comes by hearing a word of Christ, referring to Jesus the anointed one. (Romans 10:17)

So an anointed word from God will make all the difference in the world, if we receive and act upon it. (James 1:22)

The apostle Peter acted on the word of the Master, after Jesus told him "come." **Peter acted on the anointed word of Jesus, and he could then do the impossible and walk on water, just like Jesus.**

The Lord speaks to us in the Word saying that he created man to be a living soul (speaking spirit) (Genesis 2:7). He told men of old to call upon things that were not, as though they were, just like he Himself did when he created heaven and earth and all that therein is.

Now, He has called His Ecclesia to speak on His behalf. Every believer in Yeshua hamashiach has a calling to speak God's Word over his/her life and family.
