



Be A Reflection Of Jesus In 2015

(January 11, 2015)

When Philip asked to see the Father, Jesus answered that he himself was a reflection of the Father.

Jesus saith unto him, **Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou *then*, Shew us the Father?** John 14:9

Meditating on this scripture I saw that we as believers are also called to be a reflection of Jesus (the Father) in our everyday lives, not only at church.

When the unbelieving world sees us, they are to see the reflection of Jesus through us, not only our natural flesh.

How can this happen?

The answer to this question is found in the written living Word of God.

Looking at the life of Moses we find this scripture:

And the children of Israel saw the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face shone: and Moses put the vail upon his face again, until he went in to speak with him. Exodus 34:35

Moses spent so much time in the presence of God that it affected his natural flesh. The skin of his face shone like the face of an angel with the presence of the Glory of God.

When Stephen was being accused and stoned it says:

And all that sat in the council, looking stedfastly on him, saw his face as it had been the face of an angel. Acts 6:15

He was reflecting the presence of God although he was "just" an usher in the work of the Lord.

In my early teenage years when the Lord started to pull on my heart to put my life on the altar for His purposes, I had a similar experience of seeing the reflection of the Glory of God on the face of a man from another country that visited the Church.
