



## The Blessing of the Jews

When the Lord entered into a binding agreement or covenant with Abram, he did so with the plan that this covenant would not only be for the natural descendents of Abram, but that it would be extended to include all the nations of the world. God even put his name הָ (Hebrew letter hey), pronounced Hah in English, and put it in the name אַבְרָם (Abram), making it אַבְרָהָם (Abraham).

***Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness. Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham. And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen (nations) through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed. So then they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham. Galatians 3:6-9***

As I said, God in his love included all nations in the blessing of Abraham, so everyone that hears about that blessing and believes in that blessing, can be part of the blessing. In the beginning it was limited to the nation of Israel, ***but now it is only limited to our knowledge and faith in the seed of Abraham, Jesus the anointed one.***

What was the blessing of Abraham supposed to be? According to the Word, it was supposed to be threefold, namely, a material, a physical, and a spiritual blessing.

In other words, it was to include every aspect of human existence—an anointing or blessing for all of our lives, if you will.

God's goodness and glory was to be displayed through the life of Abraham and through his descendents forever.

In the beginning, God created man in his image so that he could fellowship with him in the cool of the day. ***That presence of God has now been restored through the blessing of Abraham that has been given to all nations through the seed of Abraham, Jesus the Christ.***

The curse of breaking the Law has been redeemed. Apply it to your personal life by saying:

***Christ hath redeemed us (me) from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us (me): for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:***

***That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles (nations) through Jesus Christ; that we (I) might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. Galatians 3:13-14***
