

Knowing the Voice of God

(May 10, 2015)

Today there are many voices speaking to us about the things of God, and therefore many Christian people are mixed up and confused in their thinking and believing. It has become somewhat of a fad to embrace the latest revelation or the latest minister or ministry, but few have a profound personal relationship with the Master Himself, although Jesus said: My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. John 10:27

Not hearing and following the voice of God can be very dangerous, especially when the storms of life try our foundation.

Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock. And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it. Luke 6:46-49

We here can see the importance of not only hearing the Word (Romans 10:17), but also doing it (James 1:22). It has to be personally hearing from God, either through a minister or straight from the voice of Spirit as we study the Word, it is still God speaking to us as individuals. After we have heard God's voice in our hearts, then we have to obey and do that which God has spoken. Notice that God does not speak to our minds but to our spirits (Proverbs 20:27).

Hearing and obeying Jesus voice on a daily bases is the only way that we can build a strong relationship with Him as the foundation of our lives.

Jesus shows us in the Gospels how he was led by the Father in all that he did, because the Father showed him His will by the Spirit.

Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise. For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel. For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth *them*; even so the Son quickeneth whom he will. John 5:19-21

The greatest works of God are revealed when we allow him to show us his works and then do them. This is how we can heal the sick, raise the dead, and cast out devils, and work any kind of miracle, in his name. Matthew 10:8

This is how the man at the pool of Bethesda was healed through the ministry of Jesus, and this how Jesus ministered and told us to minister in HIS NAMED.

I heard from a minister friend of mine that there are many people being raised from the dead today in Africa. The ministers that the Lord is using say that they have dreams of how the Lord is raising someone from the dead, and then they just carry out what they have seen in that dream.

We have also seen people come back from the dead in our ministry, both in the USA and in Central America. It is happening today in Africa, Latin America, and also in other nations of the world. This, however, requires a strong personal relationship with Jesus and with his Anointing.

The early Jewish disciples and believers of Yeshua were all anointed to heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead and cast out devils, and that calling and anointing is still available to the body of Christ today.

Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. John 14:12-14
