



The Prophetic Word Of The Lord Is Precious

(June 27, 2015)

Yeshua spoke in Acts 1:8 and said: *“But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.”*

These were Prophetic Words spoken from the lips of Jesus that could either be received or rejected.

Only one hundred and twenty people out of more than five hundred people, decided to receive and act upon those words, and therefore benefited from the blessing of those words.

In order to benefit from what the Lord is speaking through his Prophets today it is essential that those words are not only heard by also received and actively pursued, like in the case of this prophesy of Jesus.

Another great example is of Caleb and Joshua in Deuteronomy 1:21: ***Behold, the LORD thy God hath set the land before thee: go up and possess it, as the LORD God of thy fathers hath said unto thee; fear not, neither be discouraged.***

The Prophetic word of Moses was very clear and unambiguous, yet only two people out of millions of people benefited from those words, because they received them and acted upon them in faith. God had promised to give the land to all of Israel, but it had to be taken by violent faith, and fought for and only Caleb and Joshua did that.

And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.
Matthew 11:12

The Lord has many times given me prophetic words for an individual, or a local congregation, a city, or a nation. In every case where the recipient or recipients of those words acted in faith upon what the Spirit was saying, the blessing and the manifestation of that word was released. Glory to God!

The ministry of the Prophet is from the Lord and has been placed in the Body of the Messiah to benefit and help build individuals, families, and local congregations, because the Lord uses Prophets to speak to the assembly on what He has on His heart.

He has also put Apostles in the Church to work together with the Prophets and to help implement what the Spirit of God is saying through the ministry of the Prophet, since the words of the Prophet also have to be tried and confirmed by two or three witnesses.

In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established. 2 Corinthians 13:1

If we can follow these simple instructions from the Word of God regarding the ministry of the Apostle and the Prophet, we will see revival and a great outpouring of the supernatural power of God in the assembly of the brethren.
