

## The Reality of Angels

The Word of God teaches us about the reality of the spirit world. People are more or less aware of the evil that surrounds them, but the Word also teaches us about the wonderful reality of the the goodness of God coming to us through angels of God.

As a child, I was drawn to God because of the reality of angels. My father and mother had many anointed servants of God that came to visit our home, and many times I could feel a special presence of angels that followed their visits.

As the Word states: Don't neglect to show hospitality, for by doing this some have welcomed **angels** as **guests** without knowing it. (Hebrews 13:2)

Never was the presence of angels more real to me than when Kathryn Kuhlman came to visit our Church in Gothenburg Sweden. The images of angels were even captured on film taken by secular journalist that had come to write about what was going on in the meetings.

These meetings became a turning point in my life. I started to hunger and thirst for more of the supernatural presence of God in my life.

Every night for months, after those meetings, I would feel the presence of angels as I drifted off to sleep.

The Word of God does tell us to be aware of the Angel of the Lord:

Behold, I send an Angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared. Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your transgressions: for my name is in him. But if thou shalt indeed obey his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto thine enemies, and an adversary unto thine adversaries. For mine Angel shall go before thee, and bring thee in unto the Amorites, and the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Canaanites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites: and I will cut them off. Thou shalt not bow down to their gods, nor serve them, nor do after their works: but thou shalt utterly overthrow them, and quite break down their images. And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. (Exodus 23:25)

In Psalm 91, we read: <u>"There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone."</u>

Also, in my life as a minister and a prophetic musician, angels play a very important part. On the mission field, in particular, I could never, in my own ability, have ministered healing, deliverance, and freedom from sin to the multitudes of people.

Are they not ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation. (Hebrews 1:14)

Some people are demon conscious, but I believe that the Lord wants us to be angel conscious instead. Yeshua or Jesus conscious, because without him there are no angels of the Lord to assist us (like they assisted him) to serve Him, the most high God, with all our hearts. He who loved us so much that he gave his life for us, that we might be saved.
