



The Importance Of Revelation From God

(February 3, 2019)

This morning I had a dream about a person who was trapped and drowning in a house that was flooding, while everybody around was watching, without lifting a finger to try to save the woman's life (who symbolizes the church). In other words, it was not real to them what was happening.

Jesus spoke to Peter in Matthew 16 and told him that flesh and blood had not revealed unto Peter who Jesus really was.

He said: ***"Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven."*** (Matthew 16:17)

If we do not have a revelation and still proclaim the Word of God from our minds, God will not respond or back it up, because God is a Spirit, and those who want to worship and serve Him, must do so in Spirit and in Truth.

This is a very common problem in so called Word of Faith circles, as well as other denominations. Believers try to get Spiritual results using intellectual powers, without any revelation from God and from His Word.

Without revelation from the Spirit of God, the Body of so called believers are dead and deceiving themselves. That is why in America there are so many Churches, and so many denominations, but so little of revelation of God's Word and of His Spirit.

The letter (the law or the Torah) killeth but the Spirit giveth life. (2 Corinthians 3:6)

Dead Preachers, preaching dead words, produces dead Christians, without any real revelation of who God really is.

But when we seek God with all our hearts in prayer and fasting he will reveal Himself unto us by His Spirit, and we will know and experience who God really is. **A rewarder of those that diligently seek Him.**

But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. (Hebrews 11:6)

In the dream that I mentioned in the beginning, God's Spirit gave me the revelation that I was to seek to rescue the woman who was drowning. I went and got a ladder in order to reach her where she was, and managed to break through, in order to save her from drowning.

The revelation and the instruction given to me drove me to action that resulted in the name of God being glorified, and the person being saved from a painful death, and eternal destruction.

God speaks to us through His Word when we read it prayerfully, hungry for the Bread of Life. He gives us revelation by His Spirit of what He has done for us on the Cross, and what HE wants to do in His Name, through us, for others.

He wants us to tell others our testimony, of Jesus the Anointed one, and what HE has done for us in our lives and also wants to do for them, if they receive His Word of Love, and Life eternal.

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony. Revelations 12:11
