

The Reward Of Pursuing The Presence Of The Holy Spirit

By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season; **Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt**: *for he had respect unto the recompense of the reward.* Hebrew 11:24-26

Moses was a man that walked in the presence of the Holy Spirit and appreciated His presence. He <u>appreciated the presence</u> <u>of God more</u> than the prestige of being called a son of the daughter of Pharaoh.

Today many Christian people in American would probably rather be called a close relative to the ruler of the land than a close friend of Jehovah God.

The presence of God is not cheap and it only comes to those that really desire it with all their life, and are willing to pay any price to get it, including their own lives.

Kathryn Kuhlman often stated that she died a thousand deaths before she would go out on stage to minister by the Holy Spirit of God, to the sick and afflicted.

What did she mean by that? She meant that she knew in her heart that she had <u>nothing in herself to offer</u> to those thousands of people that had come to be healed from all over America, and even from other nations of the world.

She knew that only the grace and mercy of God in the person of the Holy Spirit could heal them and that she was just a vessel, just and a broken vessel in the hand of the Master Yeshuah.

I remember when me and my family were in Paris and the Holy Spirit spoke to me about brokenness in a revelation :"La gloire de Dieu sortira un coeur brisé", and about how Ms. Kuhlman had a truly broken spirit and even a broken physical heart, and how this revelation impacted me in pursuing His presence even more than ever before.

For the Lord resists the proud but gives His Grace to the humble (them that have a broken spirit). 1 Peter 5:5

Moses Esteemed the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompense of the reward.

Ms. Kuhlman was used by God to touch nations with the presence of God and has gone to receive her reward.

The question is what will you and I do that will bring a glimpse of His presence into the lives of people in a lost and dying world, this vast harvest field ready for harvest, today.

For only when the world sees His love and His Glory in us, His Bride, they will know that <u>God so loves the world that he gave</u> <u>his only begotten Son that whosoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.</u>
