



Give Place To The Holy Spirit Because He Needs You

The Word of God tells us in Ephesians 4:27 not to give any place or foothold to the devil: **Neither give place to the devil.**

On the other hand we are admonished to be continually filled by and led by the Holy Spirit of God.

And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit (Ephesians 5:18)

Yeshua, or as we call Him in English, **Jesus the Son of God, is the greatest example of a human (God man) being filled and led by the Holy Spirit.** You and I can also be led by the Holy Spirit just like Him: **For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.** Romans 8:14

Jesus also referred to the Holy Spirit as **The Helper**: **Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, The Helper (Comforter) will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.** (John 16:7)

The Holy Spirit is called **Παράκλητος** or parakletos in the original Greek. It means: The one close beside that makes a call, the Intercessor, the Consoler, the Advocate, the Comforter, **the Helper.**

I am very glad to testify and say that HE is my Helper and I need Him every moment of every day.

The other night I had a dream in which the Holy Spirit began to speak to me to pray a certain prayer. What was unusual was that the prayer was in the German language, but I could really feel it in my heart as I began to pray it over and over it in my sleep: **"Heiliger Geist, Bitte hilf mich anderen Evangelisten zu helfen."**

The Holy Spirit was asking me to pray for other Evangelists to get into the calling that HE has called them, in this last day of great harvest, among all nations (ἔθνη) and tribes of the world.

This is so amazing that the Holy Spirit had a prayer for me to pray in order for Him to be able to carry out His work in the earth Today, and so He has for all of us.

Let me show it to you from Matthew 9:35-38: **"And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people."**

But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. Then saith he unto his disciples,

The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest."
