



## Speaking In God Or About God

(June 17, 2019)

Today we hear many wonderful men and women of God talking and teaching about the greatness of God, and of his awesome power. This is good, we need to hear the Word of God in order to get Faith in God and his Word.

***So then Faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the Word of Christ. Romans 10:17***

***However, what we really need today, is anointed men and women of God, that are speaking not only about God, but speaking in God and in the timing of God, for the Glory of God to be manifested.***

The Word of Christ in Romans 10:17 indicates not only the Word of God, but also the Anointed One (with His anointing). **Both the Word and the Spirit are needed for miracles to happen!**

In John chapter 2 we can read about the wedding in Cana:

***And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there: And both Jesus was called, and his disciples, to the marriage.***

***And when they wanted wine, the mother of Jesus saith unto him, They have no wine. Jesus saith unto her, Woman, what have I to do with thee? Mine hour is not yet come.***

***His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.***

***And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece. Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water.***

***And they filled them up to the brim. And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it.***

***When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom, And saith unto him,***

***Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now.***

***This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him. John 2:1-11***

**A need was presented to Jesus (God) by faith by Mary (Miriam in Hebrew), but the response to that need would only be fulfilled as Jesus was led by the Holy Spirit of God.**

Miriam (Mary) knew this and said to the servants “[W]hatsoever he saith unto you, do it.”

***She was speaking in God about God by the grace of God.***

Yeshua (Jesus) told them to fill the waterpots (that were only for the Jews) with water, and to draw (some) out, and to take it to the people in charge of the wedding. When they did that then a miracle happened. ""

***The water (the Law) was changed to wine (Grace) and their need was gloriously met!***

For this wonderful miracle to happen the Holy Spirit of God had to be in charge and had to be obeyed.

Jesus had to be invited to the wedding and come.

They had to run out of wine.

Mary had to bring it to Jesus' attention.

Mary had to instruct the servants to obey Jesus.

The servants had to obey the instructions given them by the Holy Spirit through Jesus.

The rulers of the feast had to taste the wine.

As stated, the water is a type of the Word under the Law of Moses, which was coming to an end. The water was replaced by the wine, which is a type of the Grace that was going to take the place of the Law, through the blood of Jesus. The purification, waterpots, and access to God was no longer going to be for the Jew only, but for all the nations and all the tribes of the world.

Jesus spoke in the Holy Spirit of God and in the timing of God. And he showed through this first miracle what he had come to do.

**By the Holy Spirit of God we can now also speak what God says in his name, and at the right time, and even greater miracles will happen (John 14:12-14), to the Glory of God. Amen!**
