



## Prophetic Words for Sweden.

(June 9, 2004)

One of the main scriptures that God gave us for our prophetic conference with AUI in Stockholm, Sweden was Matthew 11:28-30. **Come unto me** all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you **rest**. **Take my yoke** upon you and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find **rest** unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

As I shared this scripture in Stockholm I related a vision that I had during one of our AUI conferences here in the U.S. The vision was this: standing over one person God was touching was the right side of a man with open hand and arm. Light was shining through a hole in his hand and he said: "Read aloud Matthew 11:28-30, Tell them to give me their burden and to take my yoke."

He then showed me that we are to bear the burdens of Him, Jesus, by bringing a lost world to the knowledge of the truth of God's unconditional love. I had never seen that scripture in that light before. We have been called to fellowship with Jesus, to give Him our burdens, and to carry out His burden and His will in this world.

So the reason for the new birth is that we may enjoy fellowship with the Father and with the Son. Fellowship goes together with real faith. If you find yourself or someone else weak in faith it is most likely due to a broken fellowship.

Fellowship between husband and wife can easily be broken. This does not mean that the marriage is broken. The court that married them will have to do that. Fellowship has to be cultivated and protected. In order for it to grow and stay healthy, it must not be taken for granted. Broken fellowship does not break your relationship, but it mars it and robs it of its richest blessings and benefits.

A low grade of faith in God comes from a low grade of fellowship with God. Many Christians have lost their intimate fellowship with God and are putting duty in place of it.

Let us return to daily fellowship with the Father as a child who **comes boldly to the throne of grace to obtain mercy and finds grace to help in the time of need**. Heb. 4:16

**Finally, if we walk in the light as He is in the light we have fellowship one with another and the blood of Jesus Christ, God's Son, and our brother, cleanses us from all sin.**
